This to include replacement of 5 HVAC units, roof repair over the Riverside Room, Empties Storage and Kitchen, repair and/or replace Kitchen Hood duct work. Replacement of siding and adding siding to the building. Repairs to be funded by the mortgage from Middlesex Savings Bank. This motion to be published in the April, 2017 bulletin to all members for voting at the regular meeting on April 25, 2017.
